BSFD Charter Changes – RI General Assembly Briefing

- People registered to vote in Narragansett elections and live in Bonnet Shores Fire District (BSFD) get to vote
- 2. People on the deed of a BSFD residential property get to vote
- 3. One BSBC unit owner per unit, with no owners on the deed who are part of the above two stakeholder's groups, get to vote
- 4. Total BSBC stakeholder group BSFD voting weight is capped at 11%

Proposed BSFD Bylaws changes in support of unified community

- 1. BSFD elections are held at a neutral location
 - BSFD Community Center is considered neutral given it is shared by all members of the BSFD
 - BSBC is not considered neutral given it is a private entity
- 2. Any services supporting the BSFD election or voting process offered by a commercial entity, association, etc (such as BSBC) must be offered to all members of the BSFD
