Election Process - Fast Facts	
1.) Main ballots were individually numbered and printed on color coded security paper (Blue = Tax Assessors Registration; Pink = Proxy Table registration)	
2.) Every ballot was initialed by the authorized registration agent	
3.) The process involved in counting the ballots:	
a) There were 17 people counting plus 2 supervisors	
b) Ballots were grouped into packets. Each ballot in the packet was numbered. The votes in the packets were counted by a counter and a tally sheet was placed on top of each packet equalling the number of votes for each candidate as well as the number of ballots in the packet. The counter initialed the work. It was then handed over to a second counter who completed the same process as a form of secondary review. The second counter also initialed the tallies.	
c) The primary and secondary counters represented the diverse affiliations with BSFD (Taxpayers, Narragansett Registered Voters and BSBC unit owners).	
d) The supervisors were responsible to ensure the number of ballots indicated on the cover sheet equalled the number of ballots in the packet. That also had a primary review and secondary review.	
4.) The estimated total deeded BSBC owners for 930 units as provided by the BSBC board is 2007.	

Observations (Using revised Voter Registration Alignment)
1) Out of a potential 951 Narragansett Registered Voters, 298 participated in the election (31%)
2) Out of a potential 2007 BSBC Owners, 264 participated in the election (13%) <i>(Note the number of BSBC Owners was provided by the BSBC Board)</i>
3) Out of an estimated 1575 deeded BSFD homeowners, 212 participated in the election (13.5%) <i>(Note - This was derived from attempting to identify the number of unique voters in the the BSFD Tax Roll. This is directionally correct within a margin of error.)</i>
