Voter Eligibility and Documentation Requirements Details

We have received some questions regarding voter eligibility and required documentation, specifically for proxies and Trusts. As a result, we have put together a Voter Requirements Flowchart to walk you through what you need depending on the voter type that you are. Additionally, please review the below:

Voter Eligibility

The following individuals are eligible to vote:

- All registered voters in the Town of Narragansett with a BSFD permanent address
- All co-owners of a BSFD property who can document their ownership interest.
- All co-trustees of a trust that owns BSFD property who can document their trustee status.
- Properties owned by a Firm, Corporation, Partnership, or LLC are entitled to **one vote** and must submit a **Designated Voter Affidavit**.

Trusts

We have confirmed that for properties held in a trust, **all trustees may vote** if they provide documentation confirming their trustee status. Co-trustees may also vote by proxy if a properly completed and notarized Proxy Form is submitted. Trust-owned properties do not need a Designated Voter Affidavit.

Trusts and Individual Property Owners - Acceptable Documentation confirming ownership

1. Non-Trust Property Owners

If your name appears in the Owner 1, Owner 2, or Owner 3 fields on the certified property tax roll, no additional ownership documentation is required.

If your name does not appear on the tax roll, provide one of the following:

- A property [tax bill](#) showing your name; or
- A recorded deed showing your name.

2. Trust-Owned Properties

Trustees' names must appear in the Owner 2, Owner 3, or Address fields on the [certified property tax roll](#). **Important:** The trust name alone (for example, "John and Jane Doe Living Trust") does not establish trustee status. The individual trustee names must be identified separately.

If a trustee's name does not appear on the tax roll, provide one of the following:

- A property [tax bill](#) showing the trustee's name;
- A recorded deed showing the trustee's name; or
- Trust documents identifying the individual as a trustee of the trust that owns the property.

Proxy Voting

A co-owner or co-trustee who cannot attend may authorize another co-owner or co-trustee of the same property to vote on their behalf using a completed and notarized [Proxy Form](#).

Identification Requirement

All voters must present a valid government-issued photo ID when registering to vote.
