

## **DO YOU KNOW**

### **INFO ON THE ELECTION**

Permanent residents, those who qualify to vote because they have their home and residence (domicile) in Narragansett/Bonnet Shores under RI voting laws, are well represented by those elected in the recent District election.

#### **COUNCIL:**

5 out of 7 are in this group.

The majority, 4 of 7 of the Council do not own BC units.

Of the two nonresidents on the Council (they are not eligible to vote in Narragansett); one is qualified to vote in another town in RI, and one in another state.

No one on the Council is only a beach club unit owner.

#### **LAND TRUST:**

4 out of 5 are qualified voters in Narragansett. One homeowner is qualified to vote in another town in RI.

#### **TAX ASSESSORS:**

3 out of 3, all tax assessors are qualified voters in Narragansett.

#### **NOMINATING COMMITTEE:**

5 out of 5, all members of the nominating committee are qualified voters in Narragansett.

#### **TREASURER:**

Qualified voter in Narragansett.

#### **TAX COLLECTOR:**

Qualified voter in Narragansett.

#### **FIRE WARDEN:**

Qualified voter in Narragansett.

#### **CLERK:**

Qualified voter in Narragansett.

All of the elected officials own a home and are taxpayers in the District.
