Please provide a detailed description of what you propose to do with the requested grant funds and how your proposal responds to the purpose of the Neighborhood Grants program.

The Bonnet Shores Land Trust would propose the requested funds be implemental in upgrading our open space located behind our Community Center. That open space presently houses a playground that is used year-round by community members and for summer kid's camp ages 5-12 years of age. We are interested in repairing or replacing our existing equipment with new playground features. Some of these new features would include the following: new playground surface replenishment, new playground equipment, new playground features which would include 'Butterfly Bushes' along the outside perimeter of the on-site trail that is located behind the playground surface area. The playground and associated grounds are used heavily during the summer camp season. The Bonnet Shores Land Trust nature trail is used for recreational and educational purposes regularly. A perfect meeting spot. There are Memorial Benches on that sight where the families honor those beloved members of their family that have passed on, never to be forgotten.

This requested grant funding would provide the Bonnet Shores Land Trust the opportunity increase community engagement within our Bonnet Shores Fire District Community by sharing traditions that connect neighbors, engaging more volunteerism and hosting more neighborhood gatherings.

One in particular comes to mind. It is our Bonnet Daze Road Race. This race was organized by Bonnet Community members one year in advance. It was a 'Rain or Shine' event. Tee-Shirts were sold so all that walked or ran the three(3)mile loop was identified as a community supporter by the Tee-Shirt each wore. There would be a huge community gathering at our Bonnet Shores Community Center. Pizza was plentiful! A great time was had by all!

The Bonnet Shores Land Trust and the Bonnet Shores Fires District needs a face-lift. This grant could possibly be exactly what is needed to regain the momentum back that was sustained for many, many years by this community.
